We are trialling relaunching our Plastic Packaging recycling scheme, with key COVID-friendly changes, from 6th October, but **ONLY** on the following basis:

Recycling must be pre-sorted, clean and dry in sealed plastic bags - mark contents on outside in pen (not paper labels).

To help us deal with the initial build-up, we can only accept one carrier-bag sized bag of each of the below per customer per visit:

Contents must be separated as follows and bags passed to the staff member at our Eco Shop:

- ♦ Pet food flexible plastic packaging - clean AND dry!
- ♦ Biscuit, snack bar, cracker and cake wrappers (*no chocolate bar or confectionary wrappers*)
- ♦ Crisps, pretzel, popcorn, nuts packaging inc. multi bag wrappers
- ♦ Dental items & packaging: plastic toothbrushes & brush heads inc. electric, toothpaste tubes, floss packaging (*no electric bodies*)
- ♦ Personal care packaging (*put hard plastic bottles in SDC recycling*)
- ♦ Single use clean disposable gloves (*no washing-up type*)

Unfortunately, if recycling is brought to us unsorted or unsealed we will not be able to accept it.

- ♦ If you have larger quantities we are able to accept these, but only on the following Mondays: 12th, 19th & 26th October between 10 and 4.

These must also be sorted into sealed bags, having been cleaned & dried.

We can also accept the following working or not. These items do not need to be sorted, but should still be bagged and handed to our staff:

- + Cameras - any sort
- + Ipads, tablets

- + Inkjet cartridges - not laser/toner
